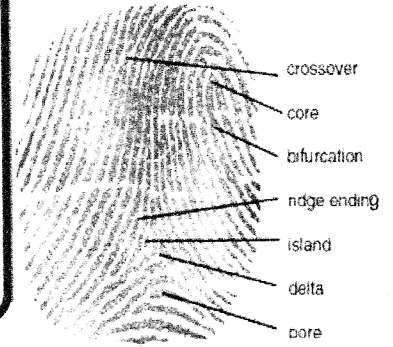


This is my fingerprint:

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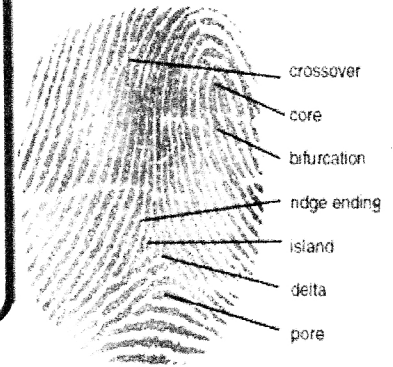


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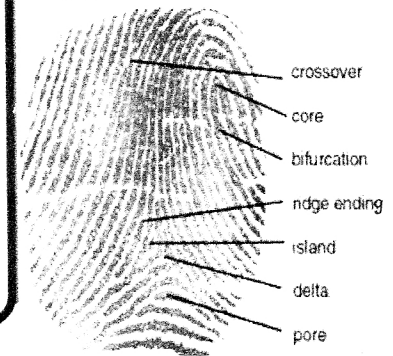


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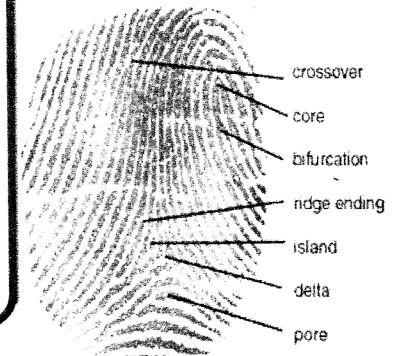


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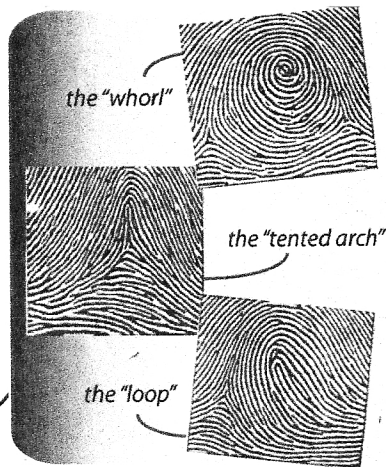
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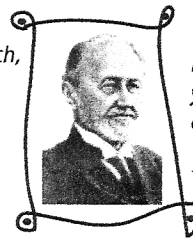


My print is called a "twinned-loop" which is apparently not so rare on thumbs.

This man, Juan Vecetich, used fingerprint evidence for the first time in criminal trial - a murder case in Argentina in 1892

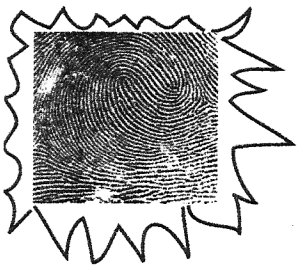


Do you have a "tented arch" on your hand? Maybe a plain whorl or two?

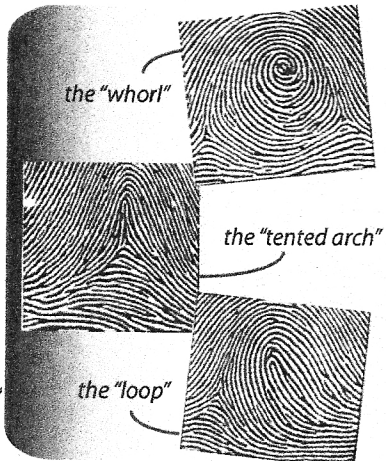
- Are every person's fingerprints unique? -

- Yes they are, even IDENTICAL TWINS have different prints because of their unique experiences while growing - you are as much "Nurture" as you are "Nature."

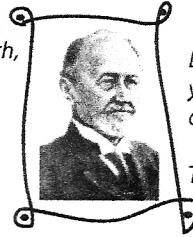


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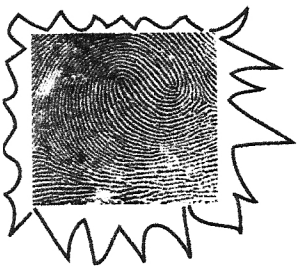


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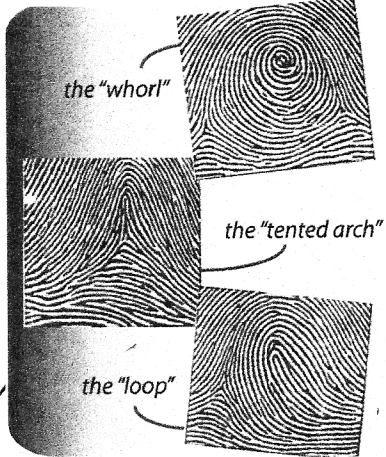
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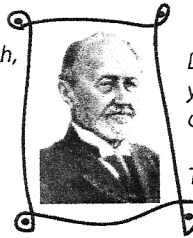


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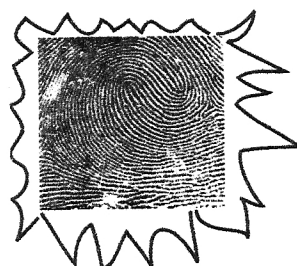


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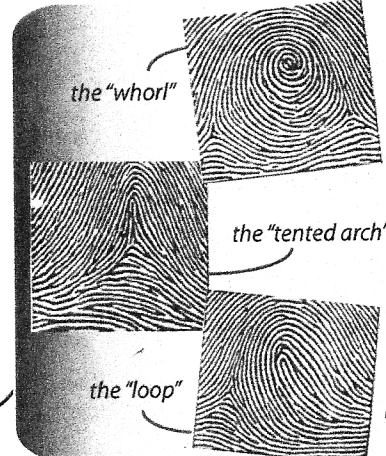
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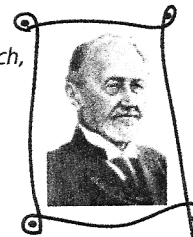


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
